**36. PUBLIC QUESTION TIME:-**

A member of the public raised the issue of adults cycling on the pavements – PCSO Boston to be informed.

**37. APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:-**

The minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2008 were approved by the Council, and signed as a true record.

**38. DISTRICT COUNCILLOR'S REPORT:-**

Evelyn Close – Hightown Praetorian are proposing some changes to Evelyn Close. A meeting with residents was held last week and copies of the proposed plans were passed from residents to the PC and Mrs Glover. Before any changes can occur a planning application will need to be submitted. This has not happened yet although the planning department have been made aware of the proposals.

Recycling – Free extra recycling baskets are still available to residents. Call 01296 585510 to order them. Putting our recycling into plastic bags contaminates it, so all recycling needs to be placed into one of the baskets or a container of a similar size for collection. Please remember to wash and crush your plastic to stop it blowing all over the village.

**39. VILLAGE PLAN:-**

The front and back cover have now been finalised. A quote for preparing the document into a print ready format has been obtained – this is £30 per page and there are 24 pages so in all £720. All were in favour. The photographs for the plan still need to be done.

**40. WAR MEMORIAL/JUBILEE GREEN:-**

The PC wish to thank Wing WI for their donation of £155.74, towards the War Memorial Fund, raised from their stall at the carnival. The results of two further structural reports are still awaited and a definite start date from Berlite has been requested.

Jubilee Green – The baby swing had to be removed as it had been vandalised by being sawn through with a hacksaw. It was agreed as a temporary measure to have these two baby swings replaced and two of the other swings replaced. All were in favour.

Quotes from Wickstead have requested to either update and refurbish the existing equipment or to completely revamp the play area and to re fence it to make a much larger area. Other play providers have also been approached. A quote for a standard MUGA was also requested from Wickstead in order that the PC could get an idea of how much the project may cost.

Cllr Godfrey is investigating the resurrection of the old Jubilee Green committee and is to contact the previous manager of the committee.

The PC has been informed that the culprits of the fly tipping witnessed on Jubilee Green will probably be sacked from their positions. The PC has been asked to provide statements.
