

Draft minutes for adoption at Wing Parish Council Meeting of 29th July, 2008.

MINUTES of a meeting of **WING PARISH COUNCIL** held on **Tuesday 24th June, 2008** at 8.00pm in The Small Hall, Wing.

PRESENT:- Cllrs Mrs M Crutchfield (Chairman), Mrs C Collier, Mrs C Hellgren-Derry, Mrs S Leaver, Mr J Nixon and Mr E Waller.

APOLOGIES:- Cllr Mr N Beattie, Mr A Duthie, Mr S Naghi, Mr M Shrubsole and District Councillor Mrs N Glover.

12. PUBLIC QUESTION TIME:-

Questions from a member of the public were raised regarding the PC's stance on the flightpath proposals and the plans for Jubilee Green. Another member of the public raised the issue of overhanging trees on the A418, opposite the football pavilion, and the overgrown state of several alleyways around the village. Also concerns were raised over the overgrown state of the churchyard and questions were asked as to the reasons behind the PC's decision not to proceed with the new burial ground for the immediate future.

13. APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:-

The minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 27th May, 2008 were approved by the Council, and signed as a true record.

14. DISTRICT COUNCILLOR'S REPORT:-

Apologies were received from District Councillor Glover.

15. COUNTY COUNCILLORS REPORT:-

County Councillor Mr Ings-Chambers reported on the following –
There has recently been a £3.25million increase in the county road budget.
The proposed waste treatment centre at Hardwick has been refused.
G2C2 – The existing local areas have been merged in places to form larger cluster areas.

16. PARISH COUNCILLOR VACANCY:-

To date there have been two applications received for the position. There was further interest expressed in the position at the meeting, and as the advert in WOIW had not yet been circulated, it was agreed to extend the closing date until the next meeting.

17. REVISED STANDING ORDERS:-

New revised standing orders relevant to Wing PC were distributed amongst the Parish Councillors. A resolution was proposed and passed that the PC would accept the standing orders as presented with the exception of paragraph 2C, which was duly deleted. Proposed by Cllr Nixon, seconded by Cllr Leaver.

18. PC's PROPERTY MANAGEMENT:-

Cllr Nixon has now met representatives from all the clubs concerned and agreed in principle to the surrender of the existing leases. It was agreed that the representatives would then consider a new lease drafted by Cllr Nixon.
The football club have also made minor repairs to the goal mouths on the football pitch, as agreed with the Parish Council. The repairs have been funded by the football club.

19. VILLAGE PLAN:-

Cllr Waller met with Cllr Beattie to discuss various areas of disagreement relating to the contents of the proposed village plan. The areas of concern have now been amended and the village plan is now ready to go to print. Cllr Waller has been in contact with Cllr Duthie to arrange this.

20. YOUTH MEETING:-

There were 12 attendees at the meeting arranged before the start of the PC meeting. There were many ideas put forward to the PC, predominately a skatepark, MUGA or some form of shelter/meeting place. Cllrs Nixon and Collier have agreed to visit the areas suggested at the meeting, along with the youth representatives, to get a better idea of the type of facilities requested and as to how they could be adapted

for Wing. Youth Representatives, who stayed to the PC meeting also asked if the PC would be willing to fund street dancing lessons. It was agreed that the youth representatives should investigate the cost of the lessons and locate an appropriate teacher and come back to the PC with this information.

21. WAR MEMORIAL AND JUBILEE GREEN:-

The fence around the play area had still not been removed. The clerk had chased up the contractor again, who assured her that it would be done asap.

A donor has agreed to provide the remaining funds needed to restore the War Memorial. The PC expressed their gratitude to the donor and were relieved and grateful that the essential work needed can now begin. It has been estimated that it could take around 12 weeks to locate the stone needed but the actual repair work should only take around 2 weeks. There had been a suggestion that a Wing Charity is needed to raise and provide funds for such projects, and members of the PC are currently investigating how to set the charity up.
