

Draft minutes for adoption at Wing Parish Council Meeting of 27th January, 2009.

MINUTES of a meeting of **WING PARISH COUNCIL** held on **Tuesday 6th January, 2009** at 8.00pm in The Small Hall, Wing.

81. APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:-

The minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 25th November, 2008 were approved by the Council, and signed as a true record.

82. VILLAGE PLAN:-

Cllrs Duthie and Waller informed the Parish Council that adjustments need to be made to the draft plans submitted regarding colours and photographs etc. In all, the plan should comprise of 23 pages and be ready before March.

83. YOUTH MATTERS:-

Cllr Mrs Collier has made contact with the new youth club leader and has arranged a meeting. Cllr Mrs Collier also put forward a resolution on behalf of Cllr Nixon, in his absence, to form an action committee. Cllr Mrs Collier is to distribute the proposed resolution, via email, to all the councillors in preparation for the next meeting.

84. WAR MEMORIAL/JUBILEE GREEN:-

Nothing further to report re the War Memorial restoration. However, Cllr Naghi informed the Council that there will be an exhibition at the church in May regarding all the villagers whose names appear on the Memorial and the stories behind the names.

Jubilee Green – Cllr Godfrey has possibly found a cheaper source for the bark needed in the play area. The repairs to the roundabout are not straightforward at present. A quote from an alternative equipment supplier came through from Complan, at £60k. The grant awarded from AVDC expires in June 2009. However this grant is dependent upon funding from alternative sources primarily, alternative sources are being investigated at present. Cllr Godfrey also suggested brightening up the existing three benches on the green. The Management Committee have organised a table top sale which is to take place on the 7th February. Cllr Godfrey asked if the councils insurance policy could be checked re the use of volunteers.
