170. APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:-

The minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 25th August, 2009 were approved by the Council, and signed as a true record.

171. COUNTY AND DISTRICT COUNCILLORS REPORT:-

People all over the rural area have been pushing for HGVs to be kept off unsuitable routes. In reality it is not easy to achieve this much desired outcome, but all councils are consulting with Sat Nav companies and the freight trade to design out suitable routes from their travel plans. It will take a long time to work through the system while users update their Sat Nav systems but at least it is in hand.

Local companies in Buckinghamshire are being encouraged to enter the Buckinghamshire Enterprise Awards 2010. The awards celebrates enterprise and business achievements in the county. Businesses can choose from Large Enterprise of the Year, Entrepreneur of the Year, International Trader, and other categories. 172. WING VILLAGE CHARITY:-

The documentation relating to the charity is currently being processed by solicitors. The charity currently has seven trustees, six of which must be Parish Council nominated and serve for a period of four years at a time.

173. JUBILEE GREEN AND WAR MEMORIAL:-

Work on the War Memorial is still progressing, however the memorial is in a poorer condition than first thought. The stone has been purchased but due to modern quarrying techniques there is a slight difference in colour and texture. Another donation from the Queens head for £45 has been received with regards to the War Memorial Fund. This was raised at one of their quiz nights, the Parish Council is very grateful for their ongoing support of this cause.

174. YOUTH MATTERS:-

PCSO Paula Boston has written a letter to the Parish Council re the provision of a youth shelter. Subject to further discussion, the Parish Council agreed to its siting at the top end of the recreation ground near to 'The Dove'. The PC will invite PCSO Boston with some youth representatives to the next meeting, to discuss their ideas further along with possible sources of funding. County Councillor Glover will look into any planning issues that may need to be considered.
